Middle School

- ❑ 1- 6-tab divider for 3 ring folder
- ❑ 1 - purple Elmer's washable glue sticks (1.4 oz)
- ❑ 1 - Expo chisel tip dry erase markers (assorted pack)

- ❑ 36 - Pre-Sharpended No. 2 pencils
- ❑ 4 - green pens
